A limited number of pilots will be available at the event and Scouts will be assigned based on order received.

Troops must submit a **Flying Permit Application** and all individual **Activity Consent Forms** signed by a parent/guardian along with payment postmarked by February 1. Forms can be downloaded at www.stlbsa.org. Click **Forms** and scroll down to **Common**.

The Lutheran Association of Scouters will secure all required aircraft, insurance, and pilot documentation needed for Council approval.
