WOOD BADGE

Did you know:

...WOOD BADGE is the BSA's premier training course?
...many, many Scouters who've completed Wood Badge feel it was a life-changing experience and it helped them become better leaders and persons? ...that it is open to ANY trained leader in the BSA and there is a course next month?!

Wood Badge for the 21st Century is the BSA's only Advanced Training course.

The five areas of study include: Living the Values, Tools of the Trade, Leading to Make a Difference, Bringing the Vision to Life, and Models for Success. Participants learn many core proficiencies including Project Planning, Managing Conflict, Leading Change, and Valuing People & Leveraging Diversity. The course takes place in an outdoor setting but the focus is on leadership, not Scoutcraft. The spring 2008 course affords Scouters with a very rare opportunity to experience a week-long course (Monday, June 2 through Saturday, June 7). Most courses are held over two 3-day weekends, typically on either side of Memorial and Labor Day (the fall 2008 course is a two weekend course - more information will be provided about it later).
