

Cabela's 2008 Scout Challenge Rules and descriptions

- ❖ **All teams MUST pre-register by May 20th as there will be a 30 team max at the Scout challenge. If the 30 teams are not filled by May 20th, late registrations or walk-ins may be accepted.**
- ❖ Teams MUST consist of no less than 5 and no more than 10 team members.
- ❖ Check in time will be between 8:30 and 9:45 am the morning of June 7, 2008
- ❖ In each challenge event requiring the team to elect participants, each team must elect different members for each challenge.
- ❖ All team members must be over the age of 10½ and under the age of 18 years old.
- ❖ All teams must be accompanied by no less than 2 registered adult leaders, the adult leaders will not be allowed to help the participants in these challenge events. Leaders will have 2 Adult events to participate in if they choose to.
- ❖ Each team will be given ample space to set up 1 10x10 easy up style canopy for their team headquarters. Food vendors will be available as well a drinks but Cabela's suggests your unit brings water coolers to make sure their team stays hydrated
- ❖ Unit flags at team headquarters canopy are worth 10 challenge points to add to the team score.
- ❖ Class A uniforms will be required at opening ceremonies and preferred during all competitions, but Class B uniforms (matching unit T shirts may be worn during challenge events providing all members are uniform in appearance)
- ❖ All participants will receive a Cabela's Scout challenge patch.
- ❖ All attendees in uniform participating or not will receive a Cabela's hat for attending this event.
- ❖ Each event will have a 1st place prize.
- ❖ The overall 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place scoring teams at this Scout challenge will win for their unit \$100, \$75, \$50 Cabela's Gift Cards respectively
- ❖ All prizes will be given out at an awards ceremony immediately after Challenge event completion. Approximately 6pm June 7, 2008

**** Adult Participation and officiating of the Hazelwood Cabela's 2008 Challenge ** events**

We at Cabela's Hazelwood recognize that these challenge events would be better judged and officiated by members of the organizations involved. By no means will we drop all of the responsibility of these challenge events on the volunteers willing to help the area youth participating, but we feel that the participants will feel more at ease working with the leadership they recognize as well as our staff at these events

For your help at these events;

Cabela's Hazelwood will extend to all Registered Adult leaders & Order of the Arrow youth members, willing to take the time out of their busy schedules to help their unit's youth members at this challenge by attending for the leadership requirement, or by volunteering to help officiate these events the right to purchase any Scouting related items at Vendor Discount after this event (June 7th only) this can be up to 30% off retail pricing depending on the name branding of the items purchased.

Cabela's 2008 Scout Challenge Rules and descriptions

Orienteering Challenge:

"Teams must complete this challenge within 30 minutes"

- Team must elect 1 member to be in charge of compass and 1 member to keep track of the course locations.
- Orient a map with their compass (both to be supplied by Cabela's)
- Identify 10 predetermined points of interest on their map
- Run a simple 10 point orienteering course.
- Shortest time in completion of this challenge wins 2 extra challenge points.

Total time points score for this challenge;

10 min or less 20 challenge points, 11-15 min 15 challenge points, 16-20 min 10 challenge points, 20-25 min 5 challenge points, 26-30 min 2 challenge points.

Knots Challenge:

"Teams will be given 30 minutes to complete this challenge."

Team must complete challenge using BSA approved knots (no granny knots) and lashings only, with in 30 minutes. Teams will be supplied with 3-8 foot tripod legs, 1-20 foot section of 3/8 rope for lashing, 4 odd sized 3 foot sections of rope for support rope and 2-5 gallon buckets.

- Lash tripod together to support the rest of challenge
- Create 12 foot support rope from 3 foot sections of odd sized rope
- Attach support rope to tripod and a 5 gallon bucket to support rope
- Fill 5 gallon bucket with water (bucket must stay suspended full of water for a minimum of 3 min)
- Shortest time to completion, successful suspension and most correctly tied knots in this challenge wins 2 extra challenge points.

Total time points score for this challenge;

10 min or less 20 challenge points, 11-15 min 15 challenge points, 16-20 min 10 challenge points, 20-25 min 5 challenge points, 26-30 min 2 challenge points.

Tent Raising Challenge:

"Teams will be given 30 minutes to complete this challenge."

- Teams will elect 1 leader for their team
- All members but the leader will be blindfolded
- Leader will have to direct all other team members efficiently to complete challenge.
- Teams will set up 1 tent of Cabela's choosing in this timed event. This tent must be set up correctly in the quickest time to win.
- Shortest time to completion and most correct set up wins 2 extra challenge points

Total time points score for this challenge;

10 min or less 20 challenge points, 11-15 min 15 challenge points, 16-20 min 10 challenge points, 20-25 min 5 challenge points, 26-30 min 2 challenge points.

GPS Challenge:

All teams will be given a short class (10 min) in the operations of the Garmin Vista GPS unit supplied by Cabela's in this challenge. Teams may bring their own GPS unit to the challenge, if so they will be given the same 20 minutes to find the caches.

"20 minute time limit per team."

- Teams must elect 1 team member to be "in charge" of and operate the GPS unit for their team for this challenge
- Teams must, in the 20 minutes of this challenge find as many GPS caches as they can (there will be 10 total caches). Each team will retrieve 1 item from each cache found and bring them to the starting table for scoring.

Casting Challenge:

Teams will be supplied with 1 Zebco 202 casting combo to complete this challenge.

"20 minute time limit per team."

- 3 members will be chosen by the team to compete in this challenge.
- Each member chosen will cast 5 times in to the target area to score points with each cast. Casting accuracy is a must.
- All 3 members' total score will be tabulated for a total team score. Highest total score in this challenge wins !!!!

Metal Detection Challenge:

Teams will be supplied with 1 Cabela's metal detector. There will be three types of targets in the field to find, with 3 different point levels. Detector must be handed off every 5 minutes to a different team member.

"20 min time limit per team."

- 4 members will be chosen by the team to run the detector for the team.
- 5 minutes will be given to each of the 3 team members to find as many targets as possible, highest combined point value per team in this challenge will determine the winners of this event.

Adult Challenges

“Leaders Dutch oven Cook off”

There will be 2 adult challenges at this event, both of these events will be Dutch oven cooking events judged by a panel of 6 judges. Both of these events will be scored cumulatively by point values. Total point values of the 2 events combined will determine the 1st, 2nd, 3rd & 4th place overall winner.

**** ALL Cooking fires must be contained in an above ground fire pit, no ground fires will be allowed because of Ecology & Fire safety.**

All teams competing must be prepared to participate in both parts of the Adult Challenge event to qualify for the prizes

Main Course Challenge:

- This must be a Main course dish cooked in a Dutch oven on premises and must have at least 6 servings for the 6 judge panel.

Desert Challenge:

- This must be a Desert dish cooked in a Dutch oven on premises and must have at least 6 servings for the 6 judge panel.

1st place overall winning unit will receive:

1-14” Cabela’s preseasoned tri leg Dutch oven, Camouflage apron and potholder set, and a Cabela’s Dutch oven carrying case

2nd place overall winning unit will receive:

1-12” Cabela’s preseasoned tri leg Dutch oven, Camouflage apron and potholder set, and a Cabela’s Dutch oven Carry case

3rd place overall winning unit will receive:

1-10” Cabela’s preseasoned tri leg Dutch oven, Camouflage apron and potholder set,

4th place overall winning unit will receive:

Camouflage apron and potholder set, and a stansport 2 piece stainless steel cooking utensil set.
