Shot Gun (with Clay Bird) for Boy Scouts located in the Nusser camping area.

Each Scout will have the opportunity to shoot 5 clay birds at this station.

Rank Advancement Learning: Animal Track Identification

22 Rifle for Boy Scouts located at the Rifle Range

Each Scout will have the opportunity to shoot 2 targets, 10 shots at this station.

Rank Advancement Learning: First Aid Training

BB Gun for Webelos located at the BB Gun Range

Each participant will get to shoot targets at this station. We will also be shooting at balloons and playing cards. BB Gun Activity Loop can be completed.

Archery for both Boy Scouts and Webelos at the Archery Range

Each participant will get to shoot 10 arrows at this station, (2 groups of 5 shots).

We will be shooting at conventional targets with balloons added for extra incentive.

Archery Activity Loop can be completed.

Rank Advancement Learning: Native Missouri Plants and Trees

Climbing Tower for Boy Scouts at.....well.... the climbing tower. ☺

Each participant will be allowed to climb up the tower and repel back down.

Rank Advancement Learning: Knots and Lashings will be taught at this station.

Paintball Slingshot for Webelos will be located at the Baseball Field

Each participant will be given five paintballs to shoot at pie tins.

Knife and Tomahawk throwing for Boy Scouts

Each participant at the knife station be given 3 knives, at tomahawk station you will have 3 axes. Try to pop the balloons and stick the knife or axe in the wood block.

Rank Advancement Learning: Knife Sharpening Safety and Technique.

Monkey Bridge for Webelos will be located next to the Climbing Tower

Each participant will try to make it across the pretend river without falling in.

Life Saving Throw for Scouts and Webelos will be located next to Monkey Bridge

Man overboard, you will have 5 throws to try and save him with a life ring.

Dinning Fly Set Up for Webelos

Each Den will be giving a fly to set up, just like they will be doing in the boy scouts.

The have to use their knowledge of knots and team work to see which Den records the fastest set up time.
