Please remember that, two deep leadership is required with any Scout activity. If a Troop is not available, please contact one of the following: Campmaster, Camp advisor or the Camporee Chairman
- The afternoon program will feature obstacle courses that will be set up throughout the camporee field for everyone to tackle.
