

CLIMBING TOWER

INSTRUCTOR TRAINING, 2012



Saturday, October 6, 2012

This class will be conducted to teach Boy Scout and Venture Leaders how to be Instructors for the Beaumont Scout Reservation and Camp Lewallen Climbing Towers.

- Both of our council's Climbing Towers are very similar and this training will allow you to lead unit programs on our Towers
- This training will not allow you to be an Instructor for the S bar F, Pine Ridge or Pere Marquette Climbing programs

TRAINING SCHEDULE ~ Meet at the Beaumont Scout Reservation Climbing Tower at 8:00 am, training should last till 6:00 pm. You must attend the entire course, please don't make any plans where you may have to leave before we are finished. The Tower has lights in case the class runs long but we do not anticipate that unless thunder/lightning storms cause us to adjust. Regardless of weather forecasts we will be there.

WHAT TO BRING ~ This is not a uniform event. Wear clothing appropriate for the weather; hot, cold or rainy. Pack your own lunch or snacks, rain gear, water bottles, pen or pencil, 1 gal. Ziploc type bag and a camp or lawn chair. Also bring a pair of leather palmed work gloves; they don't have to be new, just not covered with oil or paint.

- Also bring a completed BSA Annual Health & Medical Record, parts A & B completed. This does not require a doctor's exam and the form is available on the council website, Resources Section.

TRAINING FEE ~ **\$25** which includes seat harness, bandana, notebook, two patches **or \$5 if you have taken Challenge Course Training** – bring your three ring binder & seat harness. You will receive two patches and the inserts for Rock Climbing Training. The Council does not send a receipt back to you unless you request it or pay in person.

CLASS SIZE & PRE~REGISTRATION ~There is no a class size limit. We need you to preregister so we can have adequate Instructor Staff on hand.

HOW OLD MUST A SCOUTER BE & IS THE TRAINING STRENUOUS? You must be at least 18 years old to take training. This training is very active and high energy – there is no

sitting around and it is all outdoors (rain or shine). Don't sign up thinking that this training is lecture and theories.



Mail or bring in the attached reservation sheet prior to training so we'll know who's coming. Be prepared for a great outdoor training experience so that your young people can have a super climbing experience.
