 - water bottle or canteen
 - ziplock bags to keep things dry
 - camera with film (disposable recommended)
 - camp stool
 - ball glove (marked and optional)

Items not recommended:

- electronic devices (game boys, radios, cell phones)
- items of value
- extra food that might attract animals

Items prohibited:

- firearms, ammo, or archery tackle
- fireworks
