

Cherokee District Merit Badge Workshop April 10, 2010

The Cherokee District will hold its annual Merit Badge Workshop on April 10, 2010 at the **First United Methodist Church in Sikeston, Mo.** The Church is located at 1307 N. Main, at the north edge of town. We plan to begin classes at 9:00 AM with registration from 8:30 – 9:00. Lunch will be served. Be sure to bring a Merit Badge application card for each badge, with the Scoutmaster's signature showing you are qualified to take the badge.

Following is a list of the merit badges we will be offering and pre-requisite information on each. The pre-requisite items will not be covered during the class and will need to be completed in advance to complete the badge in class instead of receiving a partial.

1. Citizenship in the World – **Requirement 7**
2. Woodwork – **Requirements 5** (can be done after workshop with partial) (**Class size Limit 8**) -- **Class will be done at Dave Elsey's workshop. We will need some adult help with transportation and supervision.**
3. Crime Prevention & Finger Printing – **None** (Both badges will be completed by the same group).
4. Emergency Preparedness – **Requirement 1** – Earn the First Aid Merit Badge. Note: The scout must hold at least 1st class rank to have the skills needed to take this badge.
5. First Aid – **Requirement 1** – The scout must hold at least 1st class rank to have the skills needed to take this badge. **Requirement 2b** – The scout must bring his First Aid Kit to class or bring a note that he has reviewed his first aid kit with his Scoutmaster. **Complete the "Red Card" requirements** in advance and bring it with you.
6. Collections – **Requirement 1 & Bring part of your collection.** This Badge excludes Coin Collecting & Stamp Collecting since they have their own badges. Before class, research some career opportunities for collections.

Note - Each scout will work on only one Merit Badge except those enrolled in Crime Prevention & Finger Printing.

Note - Please assign one Adult per troop to Sign In and Pay. There is not enough time or space to have the boys registering themselves individually.

Cost for this event will be \$7.00 per scout (Send me your list in advance, but Pay at check-in). This will include a patch and lunch. There is no cost for leaders' lunch. Leaders may purchase additional patches at the event for \$2.00.

Please complete the attached spreadsheet and e-mail to me by March 26,2010 or earlier if possible. If you have firm commitments for some, but not all of your scouts, please send me partial requirements. You can then send updates as needed.. I will call the listed contact if any of your first choices cannot be met. Assignments for the Eagle required badges will be made by rank (Life Scouts get first preference, then Star, etc). Every effort will be made to give all scouts their first choice. If you did not receive the attached in Excel format and would like to get one by E-mail; please call or e-mail me. If you do not have the Excel program, you can just E-mail me the information. **It is critical that your final needs be as accurate as possible so we can accurately assign classes and get food and supplies.**
