

Cherokee District Merit Badge Workshop December 08, 2007

The Cherokee District will hold its annual Merit Badge Workshop on December 08, 2007 at the First Christian Church in Sikeston, Mo. The Church is located at 1006 N. Main, next to the Missouri Delta Medical Center. We plan to begin classes at 9:00 AM with registration from 8:30 – 9:00. Lunch will be served. Be sure to bring a Merit Badge application card with the Scoutmaster's signature showing you are qualified to take the badge.

Following is a list of the merit badges we will be offering and pre-requisite information on each. The pre-requisite items will not be covered during the class and will need to be completed in advance to complete the badge on December 08 instead of receiving a partial.

1. Citizenship in the Nation – **Requirement 4** – Visit a state or national Capitol or tour a federal installation. (ie: Post Office)
2. Salesmanship – **Requirement 5** - Scouts have a choice of one of three and will need to bring a) a note from their Scoutmaster that they were involved in raising funds such as Popcorn Sales for their troop or b) a report stating what they did to complete to the requirement
3. Crime Prevention & Finger Printing – **None** (Both badges will be completed by the same group).
4. Emergency Preparedness – **Requirement 1** – Earn the First Aid Merit Badge. Note: The scout must hold at least 1st class rank to have the skills needed to take this badge.
5. First Aid – **Requirement 1** – The scout must hold at least 1st class rank to have the skills needed to take this badge. **Requirement 2b** – The scout must bring his First Aid Kit to class or bring a note that he has reviewed his first aid kit with his Scoutmaster. **Complete the “Red Card” requirements** in advance and bring it with you.
6. Art – **None**
7. In addition to these merit badges, we will hold a Life to Eagle Seminar during lunch. This is also open to and encouraged for parents, Scoutmasters, Assistant Scoutmasters, or anyone else that will be working with the scout, but is new to working on Eagle requirements and projects.

Cost for this event will be \$6.00 per scout. This will include a patch and lunch. There is no cost for leaders' lunch. Leaders may purchase additional patches at the event for \$2.00.

Please complete the attached spreadsheet and e-mail (or mail) to me by November 28, 2007. I will then assign classes and return to you by December 1, 2007 with each scout's class. Assignments for the Eagle required badges will be made by rank (Life Scouts get first preference, then Star, etc). Every effort will be made to give every scout their first choice.
