Rules of Klondike Camp - Scouting Around the World

1. No guns, alcohol, tobacco, fireworks
2. Scout Oath and Law are ultimate behavior guidelines for all participants
3. Be Safe and Courteous

5. Judges Discretion will be used on all events
6. Arguing will result in loss of points
7. Any issues that need addressed should be directed to the Campmaster, by the Troop Senior Patrol Leader.

EVENTS: **600 Points Total**

Russian Tactics **200 points**

Your patrol is stranded in the Russian Countryside. You must construct and light fire. The fire must be light with a metal match, no other fire making methods will be permitted. The resulting fire must burn a string set 18 inches high. You will have two minutes to complete this task utilizing a metal match.

Time after your two minutes will cost you points. If cannot build a fire within 10 minutes, you must stop and no points will be earned.

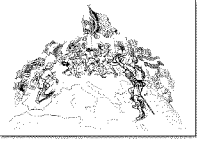
Amazonian Obstacles **100 points**

Stuck in the Amazon Rainforest, your patrol must fight their way through different obstacles in an Amazing Race type event. There will be 4 different stations, each with a different task to be completed. These tasks will be basic scout skills including, but not limited to, first aid, lifesaving, pioneering, knots, knife and axe, plant and animal identification, and basic shelter building.

You will be judged on your completion time.

Eye of a Tiger **100 Points**

While in an African Safari, your patrol runs out of water for one person. You must treat that

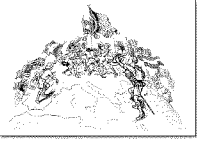
person for Dehydration. After that, the patrol member gets mauled by a tiger. In addition to dehydration, you must treat your patrol member for 3 other injuries as assigned (these injuries will include various broken or sprained limbs, puncture wounds, shock, deep lacerations or cuts from claws / teeth). These injuries will be randomly assigned and no two patrols will receive the same combination of injuries. You will be judged on the accuracy of treatment to injured patrol member.

Police Investigations

100 points

In this event, you will use the directions given to you to complete an orienteering course. The course will cover at least a quarter of a mile, but no more than 2 miles and will include at least 4 turns. In addition to this, at the SPL meeting, every patrol will receive a description of 3 adults. These adults will be walking around camp all morning and you must identify them. On the BACK of your scorecard OR on another sheet of paper, write down their name and troop number.

You will be judged on completion of course. Identifying the adults will be bonus points. (10 per adult identified.) You may identify these adults from 9:00 up until you turn your scorecard in.

Escape from the Sea Lion

100 points

You and your patrol members must bring a pre-constructed sled and have the necessary equipment to survive a night in Antarctica. That includes a sleeping bag, way of staying warm (Fire materials and metal match), and a gallon of water in a gallon-sized milk jug. They must be lashed onto your sled and not fall off during the race. Your sled must also carry a member of your patrol in addition to your gear. You will receive a time penalty for items falling off. BASED ON TIME OF COMPLETION

Note: All materials must be carried around to each event on a sled. You may bring a sled to race and a sled to carry event material, but it is not required to have an additional sled.

Material Needed

- Sleeping Bag
- Bottle of water (1 gallon in a gallon-sized milk jug)
- Firewood
- Way to start fire- Metal Match (BSA Light MYFire).
- 50 foot Rope (obstacle course-at least 1/2 inch thick, Nylon
- Compass

- Participants should have a basic knowledge of Tenderfoot through First Class First Aid Requirements.
- First Aid bandages- participants should bring enough to treat any of the injuries and/or combination of injuries that could be assigned at any of the events.
