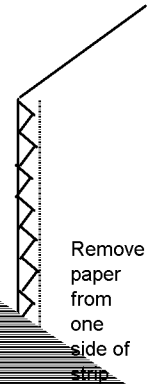


Buddy Burner

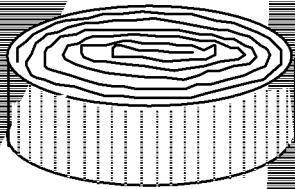
empty, clean 6-ounce tuna or cat food can
1/2 sheet of corrugated cardboard
1/2 inch cotton cord

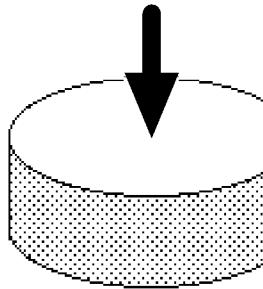
Step Two:



Step Three: Coil the strip tightly and place in can.



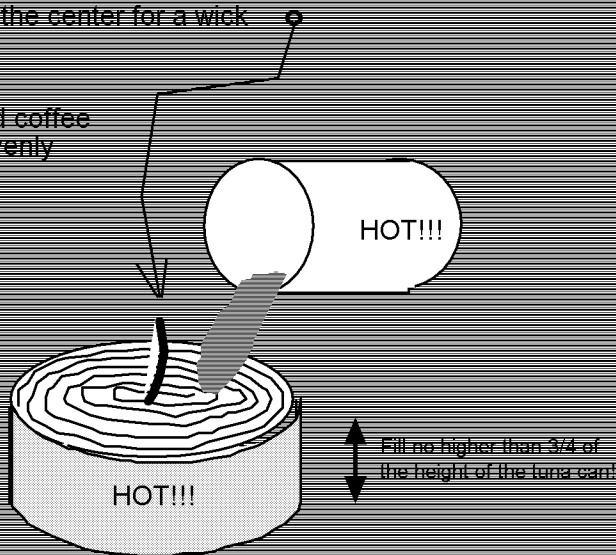
Bumpy side out
Use additional strips to fill the can



The tighter the cardboard coil, the longer the burner will burn

Step Four: Insert a heavy string or cord in the center for a wick

Step Five: Melt paraffin in a clean 1-pound coffee can set in a pan of very hot water. Pour evenly into the tuna can and let harden.



You should have newspapers under the tuna can when pouring the paraffin
