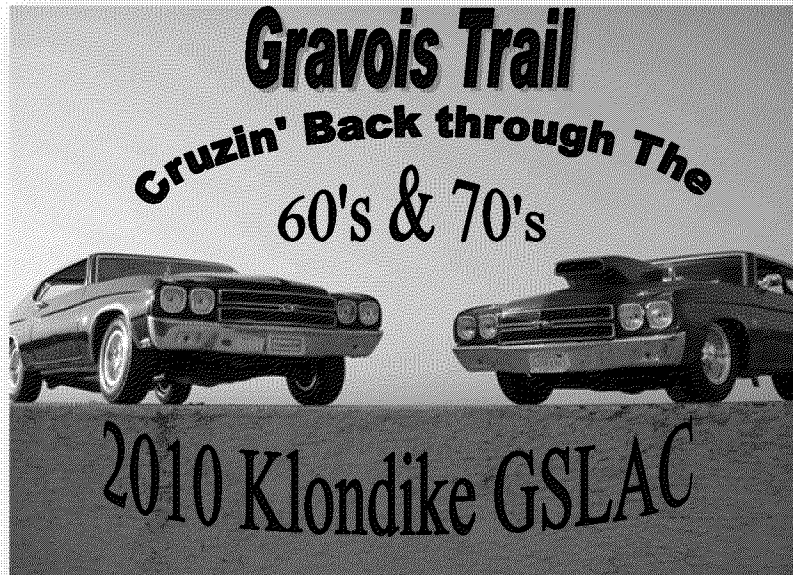

If you're spending the night, please remember to make a reservation with council for camping on a troop by troop basis.

Registration

The scoutmaster, or an adult representative, of each troop must come to headquarters to register. Remember to bring a final count of scouts, adults, and the amount of patrols that you have when you register. ***Current Health forms are required for each youth and adult present to register.***

Attire

Please dress warmly depending on the weather. Apparel must be scout appropriate. Full Field uniforms are required for flag ceremonies. BE PREPARED!

SPL and Scoutmasters Meetings

An overview of the day and the events will take place at these meetings. We will check to make sure that every troop has registered. There will be some additional notes from the staff and notifications of any last minute changes. The SPL may bring their ASPLs. If the scoutmaster cannot attend, please send an adult representative.

Campfire and Cracker Barrel

Troops are encouraged to spend Saturday night (be sure you have a permit), as well as attend our campfire. Any troop attending may participate in the cracker barrel. You must bring snacks to share with everyone. Bonus Points will be given to those troops who choose to participate in the cracker barrel and those who prepare a skit for the Campfire. You can bring a skit, or a song, whatever you prefer. Entries should be given to Headquarters by 3:00.

First Aid

Troops are responsible for minor first aid. However, any injuries that might require medical attention should be brought to headquarters. Any 911 calls must also be made from headquarters.

Games

Trick Out Your Sled

Before you go and drag race your amazing ride you have to show it off. Take your sled to the 'pit' area as soon as you arrive for it to be judged. After morning ceremonies you can take it to be raced.

Your patrol will have to make your sled the coolest thing on the road. You will take your ride to this challenge and the staff will judge it on creativity and all out coolness. Extra bonus points will be added for patrol names, sign and logo on the ride. Make it your own. We would appreciate if you would use steel screws because if your sled gets burned we can remove the screws from ashes with a magnet.

**** NOTE** IF YOU DRAG RACE THIS SLED IN THE RACE FOR "PINKS", IT IS POSSIBLE FOR IT TO BE BURNED, SO MAKE SURE YOU TAKE IT TO THE PIT AREA TO BE JUDGED FIRST.**

50 pts For creativity, **25 pts** for patrol flag and yell, **25 pts** for theme related to 60s and 70s.

100 pts possible

*****25 bonus pts for patrol name, sign, or logo on sled******

Race For Pinks

It's 100 yard drag race with a sled that your patrol has to provide. It has to be made of wood. You will have to compete against another sled. If you lose the race, you lose your sled. The losing sled will be given to a staff member. Use steel screws please.

****NOTE** ALL LOSING SLEDS WILL BE BURNED IN THE EVENING CAMPFIRE!!****

If you have an emotional attachment to your sled you can substitute a burnable sled and/or equal amount of fire wood.

50 pts for entering race, **25 pts** to have good spirit, **25pts** patrol flag and yell

100 pts possible

Throw out Stan the Man

You will be provided 5 softballs. Out of your patrol 4 of you have to throw out Stan The Man. Depending on your pitching skills you will have to throw him out or you guys will lose the game. No pressure.

5pts for every strike, ******25 bonus pts** for patrol flag and yell****

100 pts possible

BBQ Lunch Challenge

You have to cook a hot dog for your impatient customer (patrol leader). You have to make a fire, cook the hot dog to the bosses (staff members) approval. Then deliver it to your patrol leader and he has to eat the hot dog in less than 5 minutes. The fire has to be made with all natural material. The hot dogs will be provided.

70 pts if hot dog is cooked in two minutes, **10 pts deducted** for every extra minute, **5 pts deducted** after you have used more than five matches, **15 pts** for flint and steel, **15pts** for patrol flag and yell.

100 pts possible

The Best Diner Food Cook- Off

Patrols make your best drive in food. There are many choices such as hamburgers, milk shakes, cheesy fries, and hot dogs to just name a few. You will be judged on presentation, creativity, and most importantly, taste.

50 pts on taste, **25 pts** on presentation, **25 pts** on creativity.

100 pts possible

Music Trivia

In this challenge you are tested on how well you know the hits of the good old days. The more you know the better. Extra points will be given if you know the singer along with the songs name. You can have one lifeline from an adult leader from your troop.

10 pts per song and there will be ten songs, **25 pts** extra points for all participation and Patrol yell and flag, **25 pts** if you know 5 or more singers or artist.

100 pts possible

Pass The Football To Jackie Smith

You have to make the winning touchdown. Throw the ball swiftly to your receiver Jackie Smith and win the big game. Five throws at 30 yards. Everything shall be provided. Don't let your team down; they have worked so hard to get here. Don't mess up, no pressure. Out of your patrol five members have one throw. You have a chance to throw the ball accurately to Jackie Smith.

50 pts possible out of 5 throws that you make. **25 pts** team spirit. **25 pts** if you share your patrol flag or yell.

100 pts possible

Car Hop Obstacle Course

Go through the obstacle course doing 25 jumping jacks, 25 sit ups, 25 push-ups. Doing all of this you will have to carry a tray with a cup on it. You can't drop the cup (filled with water) if you do, you will have to start the whole course over again. You need to finish the course in less than 6 minutes. Bonus points will be given for team spirit.

50 pts How fast you finish course. **25 pts** Team spirit. **25 pts** for patrol flag and yell. **25 pts** extra if you don't spill the water.
