NEW HORIZONS DISTRICT TRAINING STAFF

Adult Leader Training – April 21 and May 4 – 6, 2012

We have made a significant amount of changes to the Adult Leader Training Course.

- This is Scouting (TiS) – The prerequisite for all training, is now offered on line at the national on-line training site <http://olc.scouting.org/>
- Troop Committee Challenge (TCT) is now also offered on-line.

With these two courses on-line adult leaders without direct youth contact can complete their training requirements on-line, at the national on-line training center, a MyScouting account will be established, for this you will need your registration card. They are easy, interactive, and allow you to stop at any time and come back and pick up the course where you last stopped.

With these two courses now being offered on-line, we will only be reviewing the high-lights in our sessions. This allows us to consolidate what was a 9-hour indoor session into 6 hours. ***Therefore all participants will be required to complete these two on-line training courses before the indoor session is over. TiS and TCT will not be offered through the NH training staff for the foreseeable future.***

In summary Boy Scout Adult Leader Training is scheduled for April 21st from 8:00 am to 3:30 pm, the indoor session will be held at a location TBA. Please plan on arriving, at least, 10 minutes early to complete registration. Our outdoor session will be on May 4 to 6 at the Lane Campsite, Beaumont Scout Reservation. Pioneering Kit Training - Pioneering kits are located at Beaumont Scout Reservation and Camp Lewallen. Units wishing to use the kits must have a leader who has completed the Pioneering Kit Training. Individuals should bring a sack lunch and dress for the weather. Sept. 17: Beaumont Scout Reservation or April 14: Beaumont Scout Reservation

Rock Climbing/Rappelling Certification - a Wednesday night and weekend training course are required to become a certified rock climbing/rappelling instructor. Participants also receive training for the camp climbing towers and the climbing areas near Pine Ridge Scout Camp in southern Illinois.
