EVENTS

Fire building Using materials by the event site, Patrols will have to build a fire and use alternate means to light it (No Matches). They will then boil water in a paper cup.

Obstacle Course All but one patrol member will be blindfolded. Blindfolded members will then pull their sled through an obstacle course guided by a patrol member using a provided mirror.

Creek Crossing Patrol must safely rescue a victim who has fallen through the ice. This unconscious victim must then be carried to safety without endangering any of the rescue party. Patrols must lash together spars using twine, in order to enter the creek area and rescue the victim.

Board Walk Using wooden skis, patrols will play “Tug of War.”

First Aid Patrol members will participate in a game of “Baseball” by answering questions pertaining to “First Aid.”

Isotope carry Patrols using twine and a tin can will carry a deadly substance (Uncooked egg) across the field without breaking its shell.

Log Toss Each patrol member will be given a chance to toss a “Log” for distance across the field.

Sled Race Sled race! You also have one “injured” member who must ride in the sled.

Supplies needed by Patrols

- 1. Health History for each participant**
- 2. Registration form and appropriate fees**
- 3. Reservation with Council Camping Department if you intend to camp overnight.**
- 4. Sled pulled by ropes (Your own design, able to carry 1 person)**
- 5. Favorite likeness of your Scoutmaster or Adult Leader (Stuffed Scarecrow)**
- 6. Spars for Creek Crossing Event**
- 7. Twine for lashing and Isotope Carry**
- 8. Rope, 2' sections for each patrol member to practice knots**
- 9. Warm clothing (Dress for the weather)**
- 10. Scout handbook, Patrol Flag, Patrol Yell**
- 11. Scout first aid kit (Use Scout handbook as guide)**
- 12. Fire Starters (Other than matches), Battery and steel wool?**
- 13. 1 Scout Neckerchief per patrol member to use as blindfold (Obstacle Course)**
- 14. Lunch (Sack Lunch or plan a troop lunch) Hot Cocoa will be provided**
